Week 0 Competition



Robot Name: Dr. Mária Telkes!

Nicknamed the **Sun Queen**, Dr. Telkes developed early thermal storage systems and increased the effectiveness of early solar technology by allowing solar energy collected during the day to be used at night, which paved the way for modern solar technology. She also became the first recipient of the Society of Women Engineers Achievement Award in 1952.
